EYFS Coverage

Drawing

- Draw from memory & imagination
- Draw objects in their environment / maps
- Portraits of self and of others
- Use correct pencil grip
- Use variety of media: chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencils, pens
- Use vocabulary to describe marks: thickness, length, straight/curved, pattern

Painting

- Add media for texture: sand, glue, sawdust
- Apply paint in different ways
- Discuss colours for emotions
- Explore colour-mixing with primary colours
- Explore different paints & brushes
- Hold paintbrush correctly
- Name colours
- Use black & white for tints & shades

Printing

- Describe patterns & sequences
- Make patterns in playdoh/clay & print
- Use body parts (fingertips, palms, feet)
- Use man-made/found resources: toys, toy tyres, building blocks, Lego
- Use natural resources: bark rubbings, moulded surfaces etc.
- Use objects (fruit/veg/string)

<u>Collage</u>

- Create artwork for purpose: faces/animals
- Hold scissors correctly
- Tear & cut paper
- Use glue & other ways of joining
- Use natural materials
- Use man-made/found materials
- Use variety of materials for free collage

Sculpture

- 3D junk materials
- Creating shapes with body 'Living Sculpture'
- Creating shapes with movement
- Experiment with Plasticine, clay, dough
- Join materials safely
- Use natural and/or found materials
- Use tools to cut & mould

Textiles

- Binding with string/wool/tape
- Describe & sort materials based on texture
- Discuss purpose of textures e.g. waterproof, gripping, etc.
- Lacing & threading using string
- Paper-weaves
- Wrapping/unwrapping objects

Children at the expected level of development will:

- Safely use & explore a variety of materials, tools & techniques; experimenting with colour, design, texture, form, function
- Share their creations, explaining the process they have used
- Make use of props & materials when role-playing characters in narratives & stories
