# N.B:

- Essential lessons vary in length these can extend over one or more weekly sessions
- Every child has their own sketchbook for Art in KS2 to review and revisit ideas
- Many units include Art History <u>reiterate names of artists</u>
- Progression Of Skills refer to previous learning
- Record Of Attainment add one sample of work per lesson to the Classroom Art Folder
- Classroom Art Folders must be displayed on the display stands in class

# **Art Folders**

- Annotated work is good but avoid writing directly onto original work
- Date all samples
- Ensure the children are aware of the folder to create a sense of pride
- The folder can compromise any samples of work or pupil voice add notes on Post-Its
- The folder can contain photocopies of sketchbooks, photos of displays, any contributions
- The folder is an essential resource for learning to evidence how skills have progressed
- The folder is for a minimum of one piece of work per lesson
- The folder may be decorated by the children
