WHAT ARE WE UP TO?

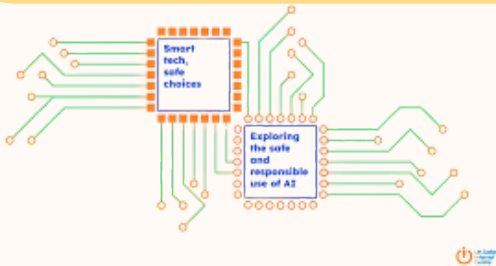
Safer Internet Day 2026 Tuesday 10 February
